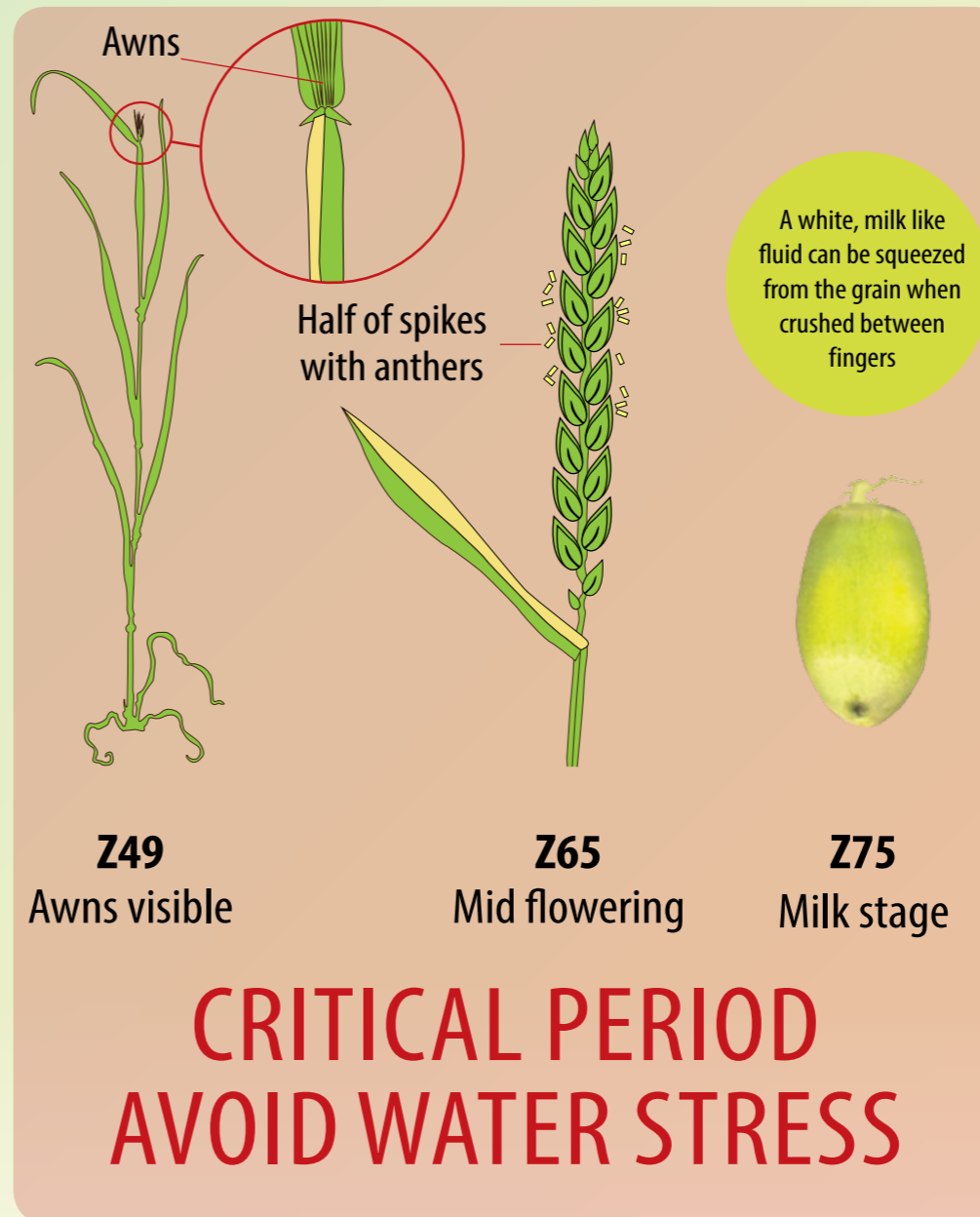
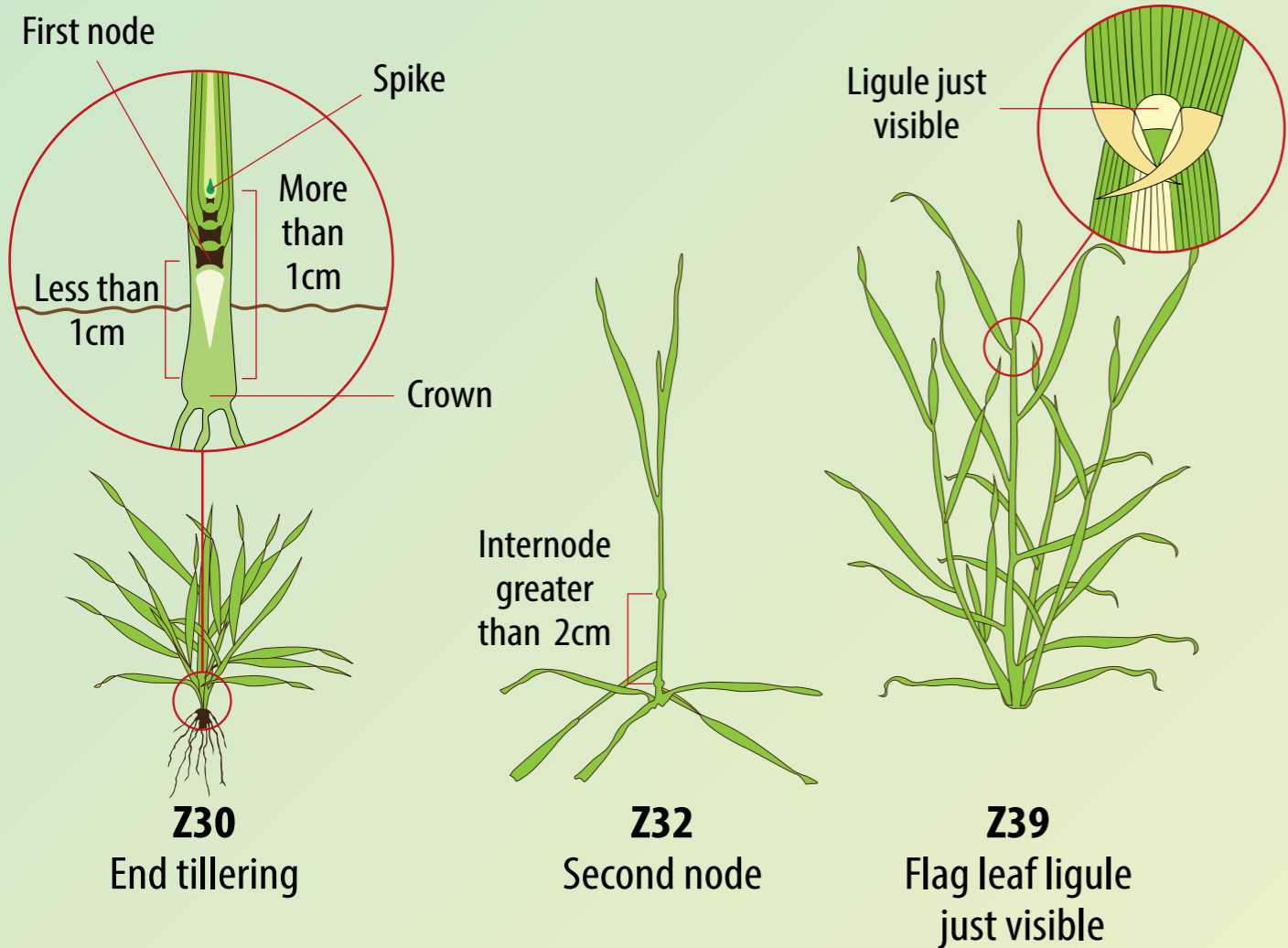


HIGH YIELDING IRRIGATED WHEAT
